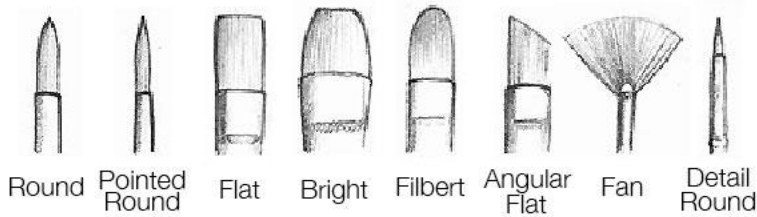


Essential Acrylic Painting Supplies

- [acrylic paints](#) basic 6 colors green ,blue, red , yellow, black, white
- If you have more colors feel free to bring them. If you just want to pick up a few paints before investing more, then these six colors will work. They can be the lowest priced acrylic paints that Hobby Lobby, Michaels or Walmart has. Or they can be the most expensive paints they sell. It's up to you.
- [paint brushes](#)



- You can't have too many. Try to get at least one of each one.
- If you can't get them all get round, flat, filbert, angular and fan. Once again how many or qualities is up to you.
- painting surface – canvas 16 x 20 total of 4
- [artist palette](#) can be disposable palette or a paper plate. Up to you.
- rag/paper towels
- Rinse cup or jar of water. We will not be rinsing out brushes or dumping our rinse water in the bathroom sinks. This is not a good practice!
- soap for clean-up
